### ALL GRADES 9<sup>TH</sup>-12<sup>TH</sup>

- 1 1/2" Math binder and pencil bag plus 5 tab dividers

- 600 sheets Loose-leaf notebook paper (wide or college ruled per personal preference)

- Personal Pencil Sharpener with screw on shavings receptacle (not snap on)
- TI-30XIIS (or comparable scientific calculator) OR TI 84 (or comparable Graphing Calculator) –

- 3 Pkg of 3x5 index cards
- Glue Stick
- Scissors

### 9<sup>TH</sup> GRADE
